

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### **SPORT FISHING CHAMPIONSHIP 2026 ANGLING CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP FISH SERIES OFFICIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS**

Effective Date: April 15, 2026

Governing Organization: Sport Fishing Championship Advanced Media, Inc. ("SFC")

#### **1. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS**

By registering for and/or participating in the 2026 Angling Club Championship Fish Series (the "Series"), each captain, mate, angler, or crew ("Participant(s)") (collectively "Team") acknowledges that he or she has read, understands, and agrees to be legally bound by:

- These Official Terms & Conditions
- All published Series rules and updates issued by SFC
- All applicable federal, state, and local fishing laws and regulations
- All weigh station requirements and standards

SFC reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to modify, interpret, clarify, or amend these Terms at any time. It is the sole responsibility of each Participant to review and understand the current rules prior to participation. Continued participation in the Series following publication of any modification shall constitute full and binding acceptance of such modification.

SFC reserves the right, at any time and without prior notice, to refuse entry to, suspend, disqualify, or remove any Participant without refund of entry fees for any violation of these Terms, any attempt to circumvent the spirit or intent of the rules, any act of dishonesty or unsportsmanlike conduct, or for any conduct deemed by SFC, in its sole discretion, to be detrimental to SFC, its Angling Clubs, sponsors, partners, weigh stations, or the competitive integrity of the Series. All determinations by SFC shall be final and binding.

#### **2. NATURE OF COMPETITION**

The Series is:

- Open to public anglers who properly register under a designated Angling Club and timely remit all required entry fees

- Conducted from 12:01 A.M. (local time of the applicable Angling Club territory) on April 15, 2026 through 11:59 P.M. (local time) on September 7, 2026 (the "Official Series Period"). Only fish legally caught, landed, and weighed within the Official Series Period shall be eligible.

The Series consists of two distinct competition levels:

Angling Club Individual Championship

SFC League Championship (overall across all Angling Clubs)

Each eligible species constitutes a separate and independent division and prize pool. Entry into one species does not constitute entry into any other species.

There is no guarantee that a qualifying fish will be caught or weighed in any species or Angling Club during the Official Series Period. Participants acknowledge and agree that prize pools are contingent upon eligible entries and verified qualifying fish, and SFC makes no representation, warranty, or guarantee regarding prize availability, minimum payout amounts, or competitive outcomes.

### **3. ELIGIBILITY**

To participate, a Participant must:

- Register under one (1) designated Angling Club through the official SFC registration process prior to submitting any fish
- Pay the required entry fee per species (\$50 per species) in full, with cleared funds, prior to the time the fish is caught and weighed
- Comply with all applicable federal, state, and local fishing license, permit, reporting, and regulatory requirements

Failure to satisfy any of the foregoing eligibility requirements at the time a fish is caught or weighed shall render such fish ineligible, in SFC's sole discretion.

Participants may register for multiple species but must pay the full entry fee for each species. Entry into one species does not confer eligibility in any other species division.

Participants may not change Angling Club designation after their first eligible fish submission without prior written approval from SFC. Absent such written approval, all fish submitted outside a Participant's originally selected Angling Club territory shall be disqualified.

### **4. ELIGIBLE SPECIES**

Each species constitutes its own separate and independent competition division and prize pool:

- Wahoo
- Mahi-Mahi
- Yellowfin Tuna
- Swordfish

Entry, qualification, and prize determination shall be calculated independently for each species, and performance in one species shall have no bearing on standings in any other species division.

SFC reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to establish, modify, or clarify minimum weight requirements, size thresholds, or other eligibility standards for any species prior to the start of the Official Series Period. Any such requirements shall be published by SFC and shall be binding upon all Participants.

## **5. ENTRY FEES & PAYOUT STRUCTURE**

### Entry Fee

- \$50 per species, per Participant, payable in full prior to eligibility. Entry fees are non-refundable except as expressly provided herein.
- Entries are personal to the registered Participant and may not be sold, assigned, or transferred without SFC's prior written consent.

### Angling Club Payout

- 86% of the total species entry pool (per Angling Club) shall be paid to the Participant submitting the single largest verified qualifying fish in that club for that species during the Official Series Period.
- 14% shall be retained by SFC for administration, verification, operational oversight, and Series management.

All payouts are contingent upon final verification, expiration of the protest period, and compliance with these Terms.

### **SFC League Championship Payout**

- **A separate, league-wide prize pool structure shall apply, as determined and published by SFC prior to payout determination.**
- **League awards are separate from and in addition to Angling Club payouts.**

If no qualifying fish is submitted in a species within an Angling Club during the Official Series Period, SFC reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to:

- Roll the applicable prize pool to the following season, subject to revised terms and re-entry requirements;
- Refund entry fees less administrative, processing, and operational costs; or
- Reallocate or redistribute the funds in a manner deemed equitable by SFC.

In the event a Participant is disqualified, fails verification, refuses required compliance procedures (including polygraph, if required), or is otherwise deemed ineligible, any prize funds shall be forfeited and may be awarded to the next highest verified qualifying Participant, as determined by SFC in its sole discretion.

All prize payments shall be made via check or wire transfer (USD only). Prizes will not be distributed until results are deemed final by SFC. Winners are solely responsible for all federal, state, and local tax obligations, and SFC may require completion of appropriate tax documentation (including IRS Form W-9) prior to disbursement.

## **6. FISHING REQUIREMENTS**

To qualify:

1. Fish must be:

- Legally caught on rod and reel by the registered Participant during the Official Series Period.
- Landed and harvested on the same calendar day as caught.
- Caught in full compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, size limits, reporting requirements, and permitting obligations.

Failure to comply with any applicable law or regulation at the time of catch shall render the fish ineligible, regardless of weight.

2. Fish must:

- Not be mutilated (including shark bites, propeller trauma, or any damage that, in SFC's sole determination, materially impairs the fighting ability or natural condition of the fish).
- Be properly handled to preserve the integrity of its weight and condition.
- Not contain any foreign objects, added substances, concealed weights, or manipulated internal or external alterations of any kind.

SFC reserves the right to reject any fish showing evidence of tampering, deterioration inconsistent with normal handling, or suspicious alteration.

Fish must be weighed:

- At an IGFA-certified weigh station or other SFC-approved certified scale, as determined in SFC's sole discretion;
- Located within the Participant's selected Angling Club territory;
- On the same calendar day as landing.

No estimated, dockside, captain-certified, or unofficial weights shall be accepted under any circumstances.

Fish may not be transferred between vessels at any time prior to weigh-in. A fish must remain in the possession and control of the catching vessel from time of landing through official weigh-in.

SFC reserves the right to inspect any submitted fish, including external and internal inspection, cutting, probing, or other examination deemed necessary to verify eligibility and integrity. Refusal to permit inspection shall result in automatic disqualification of the fish and potential further disciplinary action.

## **7. WEIGH-IN & VERIFICATION PROCESS**

The following documentation is mandatory and a condition of eligibility:

- Official weigh slip reflecting certified scale information, including scale identification and location
- Timestamped photograph of the fish with the official weight clearly visible on the scale
- Timestamped video of the complete weigh process, including placement of the fish on the scale and display of final weight
- Verified date and time of weigh-in
- Full legal name of the registered Participant claiming the fish
- Two independent witnesses not present on the catching vessel, including printed names and current phone numbers

All submission materials must be uploaded or submitted within forty-eight (48) hours of official weigh-in. Failure to timely and fully submit all required documentation shall result in automatic disqualification of the fish, absent extraordinary circumstances determined solely by SFC. SFC may require access to original digital files, including metadata, and may reject edited or altered files.

SFC may require, at any time and in its sole discretion:

- Additional or extended video evidence
- GPS location data from the vessel at time of catch and/or weigh-in
- Vessel logs, trip declarations, or electronic tracking records

- Written or recorded witness statements
- Submission of original, unedited digital files and metadata

SFC reserves the sole and absolute discretion to approve or reject any weigh station, certified scale, or submitted documentation. Acceptance of a weigh slip by a marina or scale operator does not guarantee eligibility under these Terms.

Participants shall conduct themselves respectfully at all weigh stations and marina properties. Misconduct may result in disqualification.

All verification determinations made by SFC are final and binding.

## **8. TIE-BREAKERS**

In the event of identical official weights:

1. The earliest verified official weigh-in time, as reflected on the certified weigh slip and confirmed by SFC, shall prevail.
2. If still tied, SFC may, in its sole and absolute discretion:
  - Split the applicable prize funds equally among the tied Participants; or
  - Conduct additional review, request supplemental evidence, or apply any additional tie-breaking criteria deemed appropriate by SFC.

SFC may also require polygraph examination or further verification procedures in connection with any tied result.

All tie determinations made by SFC are final and binding.

Participants acknowledge and agree that there may be no qualifying fish in a given species or Angling Club during the Official Series Period and, accordingly, there may be no winner declared for that division. SFC makes no guarantee that any prize will be awarded.

## **9. COMPETITIVE INTEGRITY**

Participants agree to compete in the spirit of:

- Professional sportsmanship
- Honesty, integrity, and fair competition
- Measurable and verifiable performance

Participants further agree to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the reputation and championship standards of SFC.

Cheating, fraud, or misconduct includes, but is not limited to:

- Weight manipulation or alteration of any kind
- Submission of false, misleading, altered, or incomplete documentation
- Transfer of fish between vessels or Participants
- Tampering with scales, fish, equipment, or weigh-in procedures
- Collusion, coordination, or conspiracy to gain an unfair advantage
- Violation of applicable fishing laws or regulatory requirements
- Any conduct that, in SFC's sole determination, undermines the competitive integrity of the Series

SFC reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to:

- Disqualify any fish or Participant
- Forfeit the Participant's entry fees and any prize eligibility
- Withhold or revoke awarded prize money
- Award prize funds to the next highest verified eligible Participant
- Suspend or permanently ban Participants from future SFC events
- Require polygraph examination or other investigative procedures for any Participant, including potential prize winners

Failure or refusal to submit to a required polygraph examination, or failure to pass such examination to the reasonable satisfaction of SFC, may result in immediate disqualification, forfeiture of prizes and entry fees, and additional disciplinary action.

All disciplinary determinations made by SFC shall be final and binding.

## **10. WEATHER & SAFETY**

Participants fish entirely at their own risk. Participation in offshore fishing involves inherent and significant dangers, including but not limited to severe weather, rough seas, equipment failure, collision, drowning, and other serious hazards.

SFC does not monitor, supervise, or control sea conditions, vessel operations, crew conduct, or on-water decision-making.

Participants are solely and exclusively responsible for:

- The seaworthiness, maintenance, operation, and safe navigation of their vessel
- Monitoring weather forecasts and making independent decisions regarding whether and when to fish
- Compliance with all maritime safety laws, regulations, licensing, and required safety equipment standards
- The conduct and safety of all persons aboard their vessel

SFC assumes no duty of care with respect to vessel safety, trip timing, navigation decisions, or on-water conduct.

SFC assumes no responsibility or liability whatsoever for injuries, death, loss of life, vessel damage, property damage, regulatory violations, or any other loss or harm arising from or related to participation in the Series.

## **11. RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNIFICATION**

THIS SECTION CONTAINS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF LEGAL RIGHTS AND MUST BE READ CAREFULLY.

In consideration for being permitted to register for and/or participate in the Series, each Participant, on behalf of himself or herself and his or her heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors, and assigns:

- Knowingly and voluntarily releases, waives, and forever discharges Sport Fishing Championship Advanced Media, Inc. (“SFC”), and its past, present, and future officers, directors, shareholders, employees, contractors, agents, sponsors, Angling Clubs, weigh stations, partners, affiliates, and representatives (collectively, the “Releasees”);
- From any and all claims, demands, liabilities, losses, damages, costs, expenses, or causes of action of any kind whatsoever, whether known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected;
- Arising out of or related in any way to participation in the Series, including but not limited to on-water activities, travel to and from fishing locations, weigh-in activities, marina premises, and any Series-related event or activity;
- Including claims arising from the negligence, gross negligence, or alleged negligence of any Releasee, to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law.

Participant acknowledges and understands that offshore and deep-sea fishing are inherently dangerous activities that involve significant risks, including but not limited to severe weather conditions, drowning, vessel collision, equipment malfunction, physical injury, illness, and death.

Participant represents and warrants that all fish submitted were legally harvested in full compliance with all applicable laws and regulations. Any regulatory violation shall render the fish ineligible.

Participant knowingly and voluntarily assumes all risks, both known and unknown, foreseeable and unforeseeable, associated with participation in the Series, and accepts full personal responsibility for any injury, death, property damage, or other loss sustained in connection with such participation.

Participant agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless SFC and the Releasees from and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses, damages, costs, and expenses (including attorneys' fees) arising out of or related to (i) Participant's conduct, (ii) violation of law, (iii) breach of these Terms, or (iv) damage to property or injury caused by Participant.

Participants are solely responsible for maintaining adequate vessel and liability insurance.

Nothing herein creates a partnership, joint venture, employment, or agency relationship between Participant and SFC. Participants act independently and not as agents or representatives of SFC.

## **12. MEDIA & PUBLICITY RELEASE**

Participants hereby grant to SFC and its affiliates, successors, licensees, and assigns the unrestricted, perpetual, irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free right and license to use, reproduce, distribute, display, publish, transmit, edit, modify, create derivative works from, and otherwise exploit:

- Name
- Image
- Voice
- Likeness
- Biographical information
- Photographs
- Audio recordings
- Video recordings

In any media now known or hereafter developed, including but not limited to broadcast, streaming, digital, social media, promotional, advertising, sponsorship, archival, and commercial purposes.

Such rights are granted without further consent, notice, approval, or compensation of any kind.

Participants further waive any right to inspect or approve the finished product or any materials incorporating their name, image, voice, or likeness, and waive any claims arising from or related to the use of such materials, including but not limited to claims for defamation, invasion of privacy, or misappropriation of likeness, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

## **13. DISPUTES & PROTESTS**

All disputes, protests, claims, or controversies relating in any manner to the Series, including but not limited to eligibility, weight verification, rule interpretation, prize determination, or Participant conduct, must be:

- Submitted in writing to SFC in the manner designated by SFC;
- Submitted within twenty-four (24) hours of the official leaderboard posting for the applicable species; and
- Accompanied by a non-refundable \$1,000 protest fee.

Failure to strictly comply with all of the foregoing requirements shall result in automatic rejection of the protest and waiver of the claim.

The SFC Rules Committee shall review the protest and may request additional information, documentation, or evidence from any Participant. The Rules Committee's determination shall be final, binding, and not subject to further appeal within SFC.

Failure to timely submit a protest in accordance with this Section constitutes a complete and irrevocable waiver of any related claim.

#### **14. BINDING ARBITRATION**

Except as otherwise provided herein, any dispute, claim, or controversy arising out of or relating in any way to the Series, these Terms & Conditions, participation in the Series, or any prize determination that is not resolved by SFC Officials shall be resolved exclusively and finally by binding arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") in accordance with its Commercial Arbitration Rules then in effect.

- Venue: Dallas, Texas
- Governing Law: State of Texas, without regard to conflict of law principles
- The arbitration shall be conducted before a single arbitrator selected in accordance with AAA rules
- The arbitrator's decision shall be in writing and shall be final and binding upon all parties

Participants expressly waive:

- Any right to a trial by judge or jury
- Any right to participate in a class action, collective action, or representative proceeding
- Any right to consolidate claims with other Participants

Judgment upon the arbitration award may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction.

This arbitration provision shall survive the conclusion of the Series and the termination of participation.

## **15. FORCE MAJEURE**

SFC shall not be liable for any cancellation, postponement, suspension, modification, delay, or alteration of the Series, in whole or in part, resulting from events or circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to:

- Acts of God
- Severe weather or weather-related disasters
- Regulatory changes or governmental orders
- Fishery closures or quota restrictions
- Pandemic, epidemic, or public health emergency
- War, terrorism, civil unrest, or labor disputes
- Equipment failures, infrastructure disruptions, or marina closures
- Any other event or circumstance rendering the Series impracticable, unsafe, commercially unreasonable, or impossible to conduct

In the event of any such occurrence, SFC reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to cancel, reschedule, shorten, extend, modify, or otherwise alter the Series or any portion thereof.

Participants acknowledge and agree that SFC shall have no obligation to refund entry fees or award prize money in the event of a Force Majeure occurrence, except as determined by SFC in its sole discretion.

SFC will act in good faith to preserve competitive fairness and the integrity of the Series, but all determinations made pursuant to this Section shall be final and binding.

## **16. TAXES**

All prize winners are solely and exclusively responsible for:

- Any and all federal, state, local, or foreign taxes arising from receipt of prize money;
- Any required tax filings, disclosures, or reporting obligations associated with such prizes.

SFC may require completion of applicable tax documentation, including but not limited to IRS Form W-9 or similar forms, prior to disbursement of any prize funds. Failure to timely provide required tax documentation may result in delay or forfeiture of prize payment.

## **17. SEVERABILITY**

If any provision of these Terms & Conditions is determined by a court or arbitrator of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, such provision shall be enforced to the maximum extent permitted by law, and the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

The invalidity of any provision shall not affect the enforceability of any other provision.

## **18. FINAL AUTHORITY**

All decisions, interpretations, rulings, and determinations made by SFC and/or its Rules Committee concerning eligibility, verification, rule enforcement, prize awards, discipline, or any other matter relating to the Series shall be final, binding, and not subject to further internal appeal.

SFC retains the sole and absolute discretion to interpret these Terms & Conditions, resolve any ambiguity, and address any matter not expressly covered herein in a manner consistent with the competitive integrity and championship standards of the Series.

SFC shall have no obligation to independently investigate every submission and may rely on submitted documentation unless a protest or irregularity arises.

All leaderboard standings and prize determinations are provisional pending verification, protest resolution, and compliance review.

Participants acknowledge and agree that SFC's authority under this Section is a material condition of participation in the Series.
